RULES & REGULATIONS

Art. 1. ORGANIZATION

To promote and enhance the sector of high quality extra virgin olive oil was established the International Competition, organized in the Principality of Monaco that will be held in May and June 2022, known as: "MOOOIC - Monte Carlo Masters of Olive Oil International Contest", International Olive Oil Competition on Extra Virgin Olive Oil.

The competition, organized by "Masters of Olive Oil Org. by Fratelli Mazzini S.A.S.", aims to promote the knowledge and use of extra virgin olive oil in a correct, healthy and positive diet and to disseminate the culture of olive oil and inform consumers about the benefits of its consumption for human health. "MOOOIC - Monte Carlo Masters of Olive Oil International Contest", International Olive Oil Competition on Extra Virgin Olive Oil.

Art. 2. MISSION

"MOOOIC - Masters of Olive Oil International Contest" is an international competition on Extra Virgin Olive Oil (OEVO/EVOO) organized to pursue the following objectives:

- Contribute to spreading the knowledge and positivity of the product Extra Virgin Olive Oil in the world;
- Award the best extra virgin olive oils submitted to the competition from any area of origin;
- Promote and disseminate the nutritional benefits of extra virgin olive oil to consumers through the main information channels;
- Contribute to the spread and increase consumption of the product EVOO in international markets by basing the marketing focus on the exceptional qualities of extra virgin olive oil produced in different areas of the world;
- Promoting the conscious consumption of extra virgin olive oil in Italy, in the Mediterranean area, and the rest of the world;
- Spreading the advantages of using extra virgin olive oil both in the Mediterranean diet and in a healthy and correct diet in general;
- Promote the winning companies in particular (and all participating companies that have demonstrated that they produce quality extra virgin olive oil) to consumers, distributors, importers, retailers in international markets, and the media;
- Contribute to stimulate and increase the international consumption of high-quality extra virgin olive oil through an activity of "leading opinion" in the media;
- Publish an online guide of the Winning Companies on the website <https://mastersofoliveoil.org/> on a dedicated page with a map of the winning companies and on the Online Guide of MOOOIC 2021 and the participating companies whose samples have passed an evaluation of 75/100 in the unquestionable judgments of the Jury.

Art. 3. PHASES

The MOOOIC Competition will consist of the following phases:

- I. **November 2nd, 2021 - January 31st, 2022:** Special registration opening period, called **Early Booking**, for the MOOOIC Monte Carlo Masters of Olive Oil International Contest.
- II. **February 1st, 2021 - April 30th, 2022:** **Regular period** for registration to the MOOOIC Masters of Olive Oil International Contest.

During the period November 2nd, 2021, through April 30th, 2022, it is possible:

- enter the samples in the competition (see entry form);
- make payment of the entry fee (see payment method);
- send their OEVO/EVOO entries to the contest (see sample submission).



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For the Orange Flag Municipalities, the registrations, with a special card dedicated to a special price, are open until February 28th, in case of late registrations will apply the normal rules of registration unless exemption is granted in writing by the Organization.

For the **Grimaldi Historic Sites of Monaco** registrations, with a special card at a special price, are open until February 28th.

In these phases it is possible, once the sample has been registered to the Competition upon payment of the registration fee, to send it/s to the established collection site:

- III. **April 1st - April 30th, 2022:** a period of submission of the samples to the MOOOIC Contest. Until April 30th, it is possible to receive the samples, after this date the samples received will not be accepted at the Competition as they arrived after the deadline (any registration fees will not be refunded in any case as the organization is not responsible for the arrival out of time for registration and the samples will be retained as "out of competition");
- IV. **April 30th, 2022:** closing date for entries to the MOOOIC Competition.
- V. **Between 1st and 31st May 2022:** the tasting sessions of the oils will take place at the location indicated by the organization of the competition or in online mode depending on the developments of the COVID 19 situation in the year 2022.

All olive oils will be subjected to sensory analysis by an International Jury of professionals who will evaluate and classify them according to the methods of the International Olive Oil Council (IOC).

- VI. **On June 4th, 2022:** the Awards Ceremony will take place in the Principality of Monaco and public tasting sessions will be held during which the winning samples will be tasted; these will be commented on by the main world specialists present and part of the International Jury.

Art. 4. PRODUCTS ADMITTED TO MOOOIC

Three separate competitions are planned for the 2022 edition:

- A. COMPETITION – QUALITY EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OILS
- B. COMPETITION – QUALITY FLAVORED OILS
- C. COMPETITION – THE BEST PACKAGING / DESIGN

A - CONTEST DEDICATED TO THE QUALITY OF EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL

Are allowed to participate in the Competition EXCLUSIVELY Extra Virgin Olive Oils in the following categories:

A) Extra Virgin Olive Oil Monovarietal/Monocultivar.

The varieties to be entered in the competition must be included in the database of the Institute for the Valorization of Wood and Tree Species (Olive Germplasm - Olea Europaea L.), which can be consulted at the Internet address: <http://www.oleadb.eu/> or <http://www.bioinfo-cbs.org/ogdd/> New database of the olive tree in which you can find the information available in the literature of the varieties grown in the world.

B) Extra Virgin Olive Oil Blend (Blend = oils composed of two or more varieties that must be declared at the time of registration on the specific form).

In addition, the OEVO/EVOO can be registered by the competitor company that sent it as:

- C) Extra Virgin Olive Oil from conventional or integrated cultivation.
- D) Extra Virgin Olive Oil from Organic Farming.

E) Extra Virgin Olive Oil with the denomination of origin (PDO/PGI) among those recognized by the EU by other Official bodies.



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In the categories indicated, can participate all the extra virgin olive oils in the world that have a commercial packaging with packaging and labelling by the law in force in their country of origin and whose belonging to the category of extra virgin olive oil has the company registered that will keep appropriate documentation at its headquarters that may be required by the Organization at any time to verify.

Participation in the MOOOIC 2022 International Competition implies the unconditional acceptance of these rules and the unappealable acceptance of the evaluation of the panel of expert tasters' members of the Jury.

IMPORTANT: the company that enters one or more oils to MOOOIC 2022 Competition must have (and submit) the minimum chemical analysis for each sample (relating to acidity, number of peroxides, spectrophotometry, etc..) relating to the lot sent to the competition and not older than 180 days from the date of submission of the sample. To be considered extra virgin olive oil, the parameters declared must fall within the limits imposed by the IOC (COI/T.20/Doc. Various) and the European Union (Reg. EC 2568/91 and subsequent amendments and supplements; Reg. of Execution EU n. 1348/2013).

The Organization reserves the right to:

- request at any time up to 60 days after the end of the competition a copy of the analysis available to the participating company relating to the sample in the Competition.
- have the analytical tests carried out by a laboratory with proven technical and professional capacity in the field of analysis of olive oil.

B – COMPETITION DEDICATED TO FLAVORED OLIVE OILS

Are allowed to participate in the competition EXCLUSIVELY extra virgin olive oils flavored in the following categories:

A) Extra Virgin Olive Oil flavored with natural flavors.

B) Extra virgin olive oil flavored with chemical flavors.

The samples entered in the competition must be produced and/or packaged by the company entered in the competition. For samples, registrations, and shipments the same rules apply as for extra virgin olive oils.

C – PACKAGING / DESIGN COMPETITION

Are allowed to participate in the competition EXCLUSIVELY oils in the following categories:

1. **Extra Virgin Olive Oil;**
2. **Flavored Olive Oil.**

The packages entered in the competition must be produced and/or packaged by the company entered in the competition. For samples, registrations and shipments are valid the same rules as for extra virgin olive oils.

Art. 5. PARTICIPATION

The MOOOIC competition is open to olive growers, producers, oil mills, social and cooperative oil mills, cooperatives and organizations of producers, bottlers/packagegers, associations of producers, traders (exporters, importers, and traders of olive oil), who have a company-owned brand.

All participants must guarantee through appropriate documentation, upon request of the organization, the origin of the oil presented at the competition.

All samples must have valid labeling, in accordance with the laws in force in the country of origin.



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In addition, they must:

- come from a **homogeneous lot (minimum volume of 750 liters/0.75 tons) for the Extra Virgin Olive Oils Category** and a **homogeneous lot (minimum volume of 250 liters/0.25 tons) for the Flavored Oils Category**;
- be bottled or packaged in containers of a volume not exceeding 1.0 liter.
- for the Extra Virgin Oils category, be accompanied by an **analysis** of a chemical laboratory for the identification of the product or by a **self-certification** signed by the person in charge of the company entering the samples in the competition.

Art. 6. REGISTRATION

Participating Companies must send the samples by courier, or deliver them directly from April 1st by April 30th, 2022 at the latest (the Organization reserves the right to evaluate any special cases at its sole discretion).

The OEVO/EVOO samples entered in the Competition, complete with the required documentation and sample entry forms (see entry form), accompanied by the receipt of payment (see payments), (self-certification/chemical analysis), and commercial invoice all duly stamped and signed.

Each Company wishing to participate in the Competition may enter no more than 2 samples of an extra virgin for each of the categories, under penalty of exclusion from the Competition of one of the excess samples.

Entry costs in the regular period: in euros: € 250.00 for each type/category of oil sent (sample). The management reserves the right to provide **promotional costs** for entries varying by date and quantity. Any changes in the entry fees will be as published on the site <https://mastersofoliveoil.org/>.

Registration costs with **special entry forms** dedicated to conventions and promotions of various kinds: in case the participant has received a registration form with facilities due to conventions or offers of various kinds will prevail what is shown on the card for the payment of registration costs.

All registration fees must be paid to MOOOIC at the time of filling out the registration form, in the manner described in Article 7 below.

All participants will receive an e-mail confirmation of successful registration and timely receipt of samples.

All entry fees will be retained by the organization and will not be refunded if the samples are sent and/or arrive at the prescribed address after the official entry date or if they reach the organization after the date of April 30th.

The organization may decide, at any time and unilaterally, to cancel the MOOOIC Masters of Olive Oil International Contest. In this case, only the registration fees paid (net of taxes) will be returned to the participating companies. In no case will the samples sent to the contest be returned.

Art. 7 PAYMENTS

Methods of Payment of the registration fee to the Masters of Olive Oil International Contest Edition 2022: payment can be done by bank wire/transfer or by format inserted in the site (Paypal / Credit Card). There are no other methods of payment for the registration to the MOOOIC Competition.

The samples received not in order with the payment of the full cost of registration will not be in any case admitted to the selection.

Art. 8 SAMPLES SUBMISSION

Delivery address: for each sample of oil entered in the competition, participants must send, in the period between April 1st and April 30th, to the collection office designated by the organization:

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Quantity to submit for each sample must be sent at least **4 (four) bottles** or other suitable food containers with a capacity of 500 ml, 750 ml, or 1 liter (in the case of smaller bottles eg. 250 ml for a **minimum quantity of 2 liters** total). Any exceptions must be expressly requested by email and authorized by the President of the Competition.

Samples of Extra Virgin Olive Oil must be accompanied by:

- analytical results of a chemical laboratory for product identification for all bottles, or self-certification of the company owner or manager certifying membership in the product category extra virgin olive oil declared in the registration;
- must have valid labeling, in accordance with the laws in force in the country of origin.

Commercial documents: the extra virgin olive oils and flavored oils entered in the competition must be accompanied by commercial invoice issued by the participating company with details of the number of bottles per type, and the symbolic price of € 1.00 (one euro) per bottle or with the words "free samples".

SHIPPING WARNINGS

The shipment of samples (from abroad with DDP system = Duty Delivery Paid) by courier must provide the delivery must use

the system with courier "DOOR TO DOOR".

USEFUL SUGGESTED ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS > For participating Companies from countries outside the European Union, we suggest accompanying the samples with a health declaration of edibility in order to facilitate and speed up the work of the Italian customs and health ministry offices responsible for checking food samples entering the country.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

The organizers decline any responsibility for any delivery of samples after the established date of April 30th, 2022, for the total or partial loss of the same during transport, for any chemical, physical or organoleptic alterations of samples due to temperature changes, breakage, or other anomalies occurred.

Shipping costs, including possible customs and sanitary charges, up to the destination, are the full responsibility of the participating companies. MOOOIC Masters of Olive Oil International Contest in no case will pay extra shipping costs (**We recommend shipping "door to door" and with a DDP system**).

It is suggested that you follow the instructions on the application form for registration and participation. From the receipt of the samples until their presentation to the tasting jury, it will be the care of the organizers to preserve the samples in a correct and proper way, in order to guarantee integrity.

Art. 9 OLIVE OILS CLASSIFICATION AND SAMPLING

After verification of all documents accompanying the sample:

- certification.
- labeling;
- laboratory certificates (acidity, peroxides, and UV) / or self-certification.



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The Organization will verify both the documentation provided for each registered product – for which each participant assumes all responsibility – and the compliance of the sample with all applicable regulations and the registration of the sample in the competition. As a result of these verifications, the product will be classified in a specific category after evaluation by the Jury.

Each received sample included in the contest will be marked with an alpha-numeric code and the original packaging will be covered to make the sample anonymous.

The tasting sheet used is based on the basic suggestions and scheme I.O.C. (International Olive Oil Council) for olive oil contests, modified and customized by the technical committee for MOOOIC Masters of Olive Oil International Contest, and contains a point system ranging from 0 to 100 points.

Art. 10. THE JURIES

The technical committee will select a **jury for each of the 3 types of competition**, the members of the tasting panel for Extra Virgin Olive Oils and Flavored Oils will be selected from among the experts accredited in the various countries of production and/or marketing of olive oil.

The total number of International Judges who will taste extra virgin olive oils will depend on the number of samples submitted for the competition. There will be a minimum of 8 judges tasters directed by one or more Panel Leader of the Competition designated by the Organization.

To preside over the competition there will be the President and the Technical Director of MOOOIC.

The technical committee for the awarding of the prizes of the Competition for the best Packaging will be chosen among experts in the field of communication, marketing, and art to give a competent and authoritative evaluation to the competing champions.

In order to maintain the highest level of **IMPARTIALITY of the MOOOIC Competition**, no judge will be allowed to taste extra virgin olive oils produced by companies in which he/she, or members of his/her family, have a specific economic interest (producers, distributors, packagers, etc.). To this end, all judges are required to provide a disclaimer to that effect in which it shows the presence, or not, of any involvement with companies in the olive oil/olive sector. In case one or more judges are involved and have interests, they will be called upon to judge only those samples for which there is no conflict of interest.

Art. 11. GENERAL RESULTS

All winners will be notified, by email and by the presence on the MOOOIC Contest website (www.mastersofoliveoil.org), of the contest results.

This will be the only official notice that will attest to the eventual awarding of the prize and the quality of the sample recognized by the official MOOOIC Contest Panel.

Will be delivered or sent to each participating company: a Diploma, a technical sheet, and a description of the oil sent to the competition and information on its classification to the oil award (any score/fault, etc..).

EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL 2022 MONTE CARLO MASTERS OF OLIVE OIL AWARDS

The competition for Extra Virgin Oils will have a main category (Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere) with 21 international Prizes + 9 National Prizes (Orange Flag Municipalities and Best Oils of the Liguria Region) and 3 special prizes for the category Grimaldi Historic Sites of Monaco:

- The 3 highest scores in each category (**Light Fruity, Medium Fruity, Intense/Robust Fruity**) (Total 9);
- The 3 highest scores for each type/category of oil (**Mono-varietal, Blend, PDO/PGI, Organic**) (Total 12);



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- The 3 highest scores among all participating oils (**Special Overall Category**). Each Oil will have its own evaluation based on an algorithm of evaluation based on the votes expressed by the Jury in the determination of the Finals that will determine the three overall awards of liking (Total 3).

SPECIAL AWARD 2022 MONTE CARLO MASTERS OF OLIVE OIL FOR ORANGE MUNICIPALITIES

For the 2022 Edition, a special prize for the representatives of the ITALIAN ORANGE FLAG MUNICIPALITIES is established following the collaboration relationship signed with the Association.

Prizes will be awarded to the first three classified among all registered representatives of the "Orange Flag Municipalities", furthermore each registered champion will compete regularly in the respective category of assignment in the general competition.

SPECIAL AWARD 2022 MONTE CARLO MASTERS OF OLIVE OIL FOR HISTORICAL SITES GRIMALDI

For the 2022 edition, a special prize for the representatives of the GRIMALDI HISTORIC SITES OF MONACO will be awarded following the partnership signed with the Association.

Prizes will be awarded to the first three classified among all the registered representatives of the "Grimaldi Historic Sites of Monaco" will be awarded a prize, and each registered champion will compete regularly in their respective category in the general competition.

SPECIAL AWARD 2022 MONTE CARLO MASTERS OF OLIVE OIL – BEST FROM LIGURIA REGION

- A special regional prize will be awarded to the first 3 classified Extra Virgin Olive Oils from the Liguria Region (a total of 3 dedicated prizes).
- A special regional prize will be awarded to the first 3 classified PDO Extra Virgin Olive Oils from the Liguria Region (a total of 3 dedicated prizes).

GENERAL AWARD RULES

No, more than 2 prizes may be awarded to the same oil: Fruity category prize, Subcategory prize in which the oil has the highest score awarded by the Jury.

GENERAL QUALITY RECOGNITIONS OUTSIDE FROM MEDALS

1. **GOOD QUALITY STANDARD AWARD:** all companies whose oils in the competition will have achieved an evaluation by the Jury between 65/100 and 75/100 will receive the Diploma/Jury Certification of Good Quality Standard **GQS**.
2. **HIGH-QUALITY STANDARD AWARD:** all companies whose oils in the competition will have achieved an evaluation by the Jury greater than 75/100 will receive the Diploma/Certification of the Jury of MOOIC High-Quality Standard **HQS**.

The Companies and those that have achieved **HQS** or **GQS** will receive by e-mail both the diploma and the certification label of the award.



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2022 MONTE CARLO MASTERS OF OLIVE OIL FLAVOURED/INFUSED OILS AWARDS

- International prizes will be awarded to the 3 highest scores in the category Flavoured oils "natural".
- International prizes will be awarded to the 3 highest scores in the "chemically flavored" category.

A maximum of 6 international prizes will therefore be awarded in total;

BEST PACKAGING/DESIGN AWARDS 2022 MONTE CARLO MASTERS OF OLIVE OIL

- International prizes will be awarded to the three highest scores in the Extra Virgin Oils category:
- International prizes will be awarded to the 3 highest scores in the Flavoured Oils category.

A maximum of 6 international prizes will therefore be awarded in total.

SPECIAL PRIZE LABELS FOR MARKETING

Prize labels (reproduction of the Prize Certification Shield) will be available for purchase at a price of € 150.00 per 1,000 stickers - not divisible (excluding shipping costs). Prize stickers are a valuable marketing tool to increase sales and create brand awareness.

If the winning company would like to print the prize directly on their label, they should contact labels@mastersofoliveoil.org for a quote.

The use of the stickers is limited only to the awarded product/lot and only to the volumes declared at the competition registration. ANY OTHER USE IS PROHIBITED.

Each awarded oil will be included by right on a page of the new **MOOOIC 2022 ONLINE GEOLOCALISED GUIDE**; the participating companies whose samples have been judged to be of deserving quality Top-Quality Ranked HQS (with evaluation > 75/100) at the sole discretion of the Jury may also be included in the Online Guide.

Art. 12. LEGAL PROVISIONS

The technical committee of the MOOOIC competition has every right to carry out an analytical control of the Extra Virgin Olive Oils that will win prizes, by sending a sample to an analytical laboratory to certify commercial conformity.

A sample of all the winning oils (one or more bottles) will be kept, by the President of the competition, for 30 days after the conclusion of the prize so that it can be subjected to analysis and checks if necessary.

Only after that date, all the retained samples can be used for actions of promotion and dissemination of the quality of OEVO/EVOO in schools, academies, exhibition events, public or private generic activities aimed at spreading the culture of oil and its promotion.

The individual participating company or individual is responsible for all the data on the entry form and invitations and the Competition Technical Committee has the right to verify their authenticity. Each company participating with one or more samples in the Competition indemnifies as of now the Organization of MOOOIC 2021 from any possible implication resulting from false or erroneous declarations provided with the registration to the competition, the filling in of the relative forms, and the sending of the samples.

INSINDACABILITY OF THE EVALUATIONS AND CONTESTATIONS: in no case the samples will be submitted again to tasting as the deliberation of the jury of the competition is unchallengeable AND ACCEPTED IN ADVANCE WITH THE REGISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES OF THE 2022 MOOOIC COMPETITION; it is recalled that participation in the MOOOIC, implies the specific acceptance of this rule.

It is illegal to reproduce or falsify, the name, the logo of the competition deposited and registered, the sticker and the certificate of the prizes won; the certificate of attestation of the prize won, the name and the logo of the competition



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are of free use, exclusively for the winning companies. Offenders will be prosecuted to the fullest extent permitted by law.

In the event of legal disputes with MOOOIC - Masters of Olive Oil International Contest 2022, the only competent court shall be that of IMPERIA (Italy), regardless of the nationality of the participant. Only documents are written in Italian and/or English will be considered official for the international competition.
